Parents and Coaches of HWYBB,

This is an important reminder about dropping off children at any HWYBB Travel or Rec practice/game facilities. This applies to drop off at ALL practice/game facilities, including the Hamilton Wenham Rec Center, MRMS, Buker, Winthrop, Cutler, Pingree School and Shore Country Day School. If we have further issues at our practice/game facilities involving HW youth basketball players then we run the risk of losing certain gym privileges. It is very important that these guidelines be followed!

When dropping off, all players need to be brought into the building by an adult. More specifically, parents should not drop the child off outside the building and allow the child to enter the building on their own.

Once inside the building, players may not be left at the facility unless there is a coach present, or another adult has agreed to take responsibility for your child until a coach arrives.

Coaches are asked to arrive at least 10 minutes before practice starts to help ensure that the coach will be there when drop off is occurring.

The above is designed to ensure that there will be an adult presence at all times in all of the facilities that HWYBB will be using during the current year. If anyone runs into any issues or feels that our players are not behaving appropriately, we ask that you immediately notify your team's coach and/or the HWYBB Board using the below contact info:
